AN ACT concerning

REVISED 9-1-1 MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE LOCAL LAW CONCERNING THE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS OF 9-1-1 TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY WITH THE AMENDED STATE ENABLING LEGISLATION THAT Allows FOR AN INCREASE IN THE 9-1-1 FEE TO COVER PROJECTED OPERATIONAL COSTS FOR THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR.

BY amending:

Chapter 236-2 – Switched local exchange access service

Code of Charles County, Maryland

(2023 Edition)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Charles County, Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 236

FEES

236-2. SWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE

There is hereby imposed an additional charge of **\$0.75** [~~\$0.25~~] per month **PER SWITCHED**

LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE OR CMRS OR OTHER 9-1-1-ACCESSIBLE SERVICE not to exceed **\$2.50** **[\$0.75]** to be applied to all current bills for **9-1-1** **[911]** telephone service within Charles County, Maryland, under the authority of **AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE §1-311** **[Article 41, § 18-105e]** of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE EFFECT SIXTY-FIVE (65) DAYS FROM THE DATE IT BECOMES LAW.
