12 AN ACT concerning

13 **REVISED 9-1-1 MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS**

14 FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE LOCAL LAW CONCERNING THE
15 MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS OF 9-1-1 TO ENSURE CONSISTENCY WITH THE
16 AMENDED STATE ENABLING LEGISLATION THAT ALLOWS FOR AN INCREASE IN
17 THE 9-1-1 FEE TO COVER PROJECTED OPERATIONAL COSTS FOR THE FOLLOWING
18 FISCAL YEAR.

21 Chapter 236-2 – Switched local exchange access service
22 *Code of Charles County, Maryland*
23 *(2023 Edition)*

25 **SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CHARLES**
26 **COUNTY, MARYLAND, that the Laws of Charles County, Maryland read as follows:**

31 **236-2. SWITCHED LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE**

32 There is hereby imposed an additional charge of **\$0.75** [~~\$0.25~~] per month **PER SWITCHED**

1 **LOCAL EXCHANGE ACCESS SERVICE OR CMRS OR OTHER 9-1-1-ACCESSIBLE**
2 **SERVICE** not to exceed **\$2.50** [~~\$0.75~~] to be applied to all current bills for **9-1-1** [~~911~~] telephone
3 service within Charles County, Maryland, under the authority of **AND IN ACCORDANCE**
4 **WITH PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE §1-311** [~~Article 41, § 18-105e~~] of the Annotated Code of
5 Maryland.

7 **SECTION 2. *AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, THAT THIS ACT SHALL TAKE***
8 **EFFECT SIXTY-FIVE (65) DAYS FROM THE DATE IT BECOMES LAW.**
