### National Crime Victims' Rights Week

**WHEREAS**, National Crime Victims' Rights Week, presents an opportunity to commit to ensuring that all victims of crime, even those who are challenging to reach or serve, are offered culturally and linguistically accessible and appropriate services in the aftermath of crime; and
