



Who is hosting the concert series?

The Mixtape Concert Series was created by Charles County Government Department of Recreation, Parks, and Tourism.

When do doors open?

Doors are at 6:00 pm.

What is the difference between tickets?

General Admission: Stadium seating on a first come first served basis.

VIP: Each ticket includes access for the to the exclusive Legends Club, an air-conditioned indoor clubhouse with a private bar and restroom as well as VIP only outdoor seating.

Suite: Suite packages include 15 Tickets in a Private Luxury, air-conditioned Suite with private restroom and wait staff. Catering options are available and must be ordered in advance. A limited catering menu is available on the event date and stadium concessions are available.

What is your Ticket Exchange/Refund Policy?

Concerts will be rain or shine. No exchanges. Refunds will be granted on a limited basis. In the event of cancelation due to inclement weather, force majeure event, or other reason, tickets will be refunded minus any applicable service fees.

Where are the concerts being held and how do I get there?

Regency Furniture Stadium in Charles County, Maryland, located in Waldorf – St. Charles just south of Billingsley Road, the new East/West highway connecting US Route 301 and MD Route 5.

The street address is 11765 St. Linus Drive, Waldorf, MD 20602

How much is parking?

Parking is FREE in all stadium parking lots, and done on a first-come, first-served basis.

The parking lot is privately operated, therefore overnight parking is not permitted. All violators will be towed.

Can I bring my own food and drink into the concert?

Regency Furniture Stadium prohibits any outside food or beverage. Sealed bottled water is allowed. Reusable water bottles and/or food containers are not permitted for special events.

What is the Stadium Smoking Policy?

Regency Furniture Stadium IS A NON-SMOKING FACILITY for games and events at the ballpark. This includes but is not limited to cigarettes, vape devices, and e-cigarettes. Reentry is not allowed for special events in the stadium.

What type of payments are accepted at the ballpark?

Regency Furniture Stadium is a CASHLESS facility. They accept all major credit cards. The Concession stands accept Apple Pay, however the box office and team store do not.

Does Regency Furniture Stadium sell concessions items?

A true “Taste of Southern Maryland” can be found at Regency Furniture Stadium. There are two main concession areas, one on either side of the concourse, featuring various ballpark staples. There are also a variety of specialty stands and portables located throughout the park. The concession stands are cashless and accept all credit cards and Apple pay. Come hungry and leave happy!

Are there family restrooms available?

Yes! Regency Furniture Stadium offers a family restroom on the first base concourse and a mother's nursing station on the third base concourse, both of which are handicapped accessible. Both facilities are also equipped with a baby-changing station and secure doors.

Is there a first aid station in the ballpark?

The Trolling Law First Aid Station is located on the first base concourse, next to The Crab Shack Team Store.

Bag Policy

Bags, backpacks and large purses will not be permitted inside Regency Furniture Stadium. Only clear bags made of plastic, vinyl or PVC no larger than 6x8x2 inches, will be allowed inside the stadium. Clear bags may not have an all-over print or decoration that prohibits full view of its contents and may contain a strap, but metal or chain straps are prohibited. Guests are also welcome to bring wallets (sized to be carried in the front or back pocket) no larger than 5x3.5 inches and one quart or smaller clear plastic storage/freezer bags.

Charles County Government reserves the right to refuse items which may cause a danger or disruption to the event or to other guests, or which are in breach of building policies and/or the list of prohibited items. Prohibited items discovered during security checkpoints must be either returned to the owner's vehicle or discarded. No safekeeping locations will be provided at the event. Prohibited items discovered inside the venue or any items left unattended are subject to confiscation and proper disposal. All attendees accept full liability for any personal items brought into the event.

Prohibited items at Regency Furniture Stadium, but are not limited to, the following:

Weapons & Dangerous Items

- Weapons (guns, knives, chains, spikes, projectiles, tasers, mace/pepper spray)
- Alcohol
- Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia

- Gambling paraphernalia

Personal Items

- Outside food and beverages
- Cans, bottles, coolers, or any beverage/food container including metal or glass reusable water bottles
- Animals (except service animals)
- Wrapped gifts or packages
- Skateboards, long boards, “Razor” style boards, hoverboards, footwear with wheels
- Blankets and/or playmats
- Non-collapsible umbrellas

Recording Devices, Noise Makers & Signs

- Video and audio recording devices (except cell phones and small point & shoot cameras)
- Cameras with detachable lenses
- Monopods, tripods, or poles
- Selfie sticks, selfie lights, or other detachable lighting sources
- Noisemakers such as air horns, sirens, kazoos, whistles (except Birdie personal safety alarms)
- Laser pointers/pens or glow sticks
- Balloons
