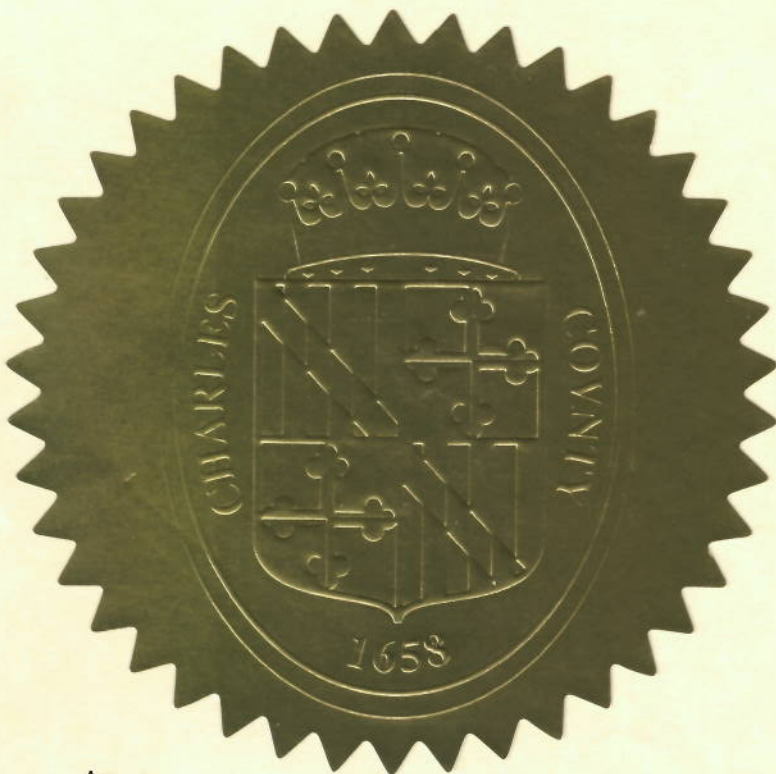
WHEREAS, Charles County is committed to helping all individuals live longer, healthier, more active lives in the community of their choosing for as long as possible; and
