WHEREAS, Small Business Saturday was established by American Express in 2010 and officially cosponsored by the U.S. Small Business Administration SBA since 2011, and has become an important part of small business' busiest shopping season; and

WHEREAS, observed each year on the Saturday following Thanksgiving, it is a day set aside to support local entrepreneurs who play a vital role in creating jobs and economic opportunities across our communities; and

WHEREAS, Charles County has over 2,400 small businesses that employ over 34,000 people with payroll of over 1.28 (one point two eight) billion dollars annually; and
