Game Structure:

Games will consist of one (1) sixteen-minute half. Each half will consist of two (2) eight (8) minute quarters.

Teams will get a five (5) minute warm up during their first game only. Warmups will be two (2) minutes for every game after. No halftimes necessary.

Jamboree will follow Department of Recreation, Parks, & Tourism Youth Basketball Guidelines on mandatory play, pressure defense, free throw shooting and game structure.

Players are to report to the scorer table first before entering the game.

Only 2 coaches, 1 team mom and players will be allowed on game floor or team sidelines. Team moms will only be allowed on the sidelines for the Jamboree. **Team Moms are not allowed on the sideline during regular season games.**

Parents will sit in designated areas only.

Coaches will be allowed on the floor during the first two games. Coaches must go to the sideline for the last game(s). Only one coach is allowed on the floor per game. Only one coach may be standing at a time.

Each team will be given one 20 second time out per quarter.

Team conduct is the responsibility of the Head Coach. Please be sure that you are managing the behavior of your players, staff, and parents.

Coaches Instructions:

All teams are to arrive 30 minutes before their first game.

Please have your team lined up and ready to come on to the floor at the 2-minute mark of the game before you play.

Once your game is over, please take your team to their designated rest area and stay together. **This time is to be used for teaching, watching other teams play, and team building.**

Please be sure to let your parents know do not drop off their child and leave. It will be the coach's responsibility to stay with that child until the parent returns to pick up. This event could last anywhere from between 2 to 4 hours.
