Donnell Rogers is the President and Chief Executive Officer of Security, Emergency Management & K-9 operations (SEKOPS). In 2014, he retired as a First Sergeant after serving twenty years of active-duty service in the United States Army. He has a comprehensive background in personal protection, emergency management, training and development, strategic planning, and security operations derived from his extensive experience at the 82nd Airborne, Noncommissioned Officer Academy, Universities, and conducting military operations both domestically and abroad.

Mr. Rogers is widely recognized as a subject matter expert in security and emergency management. He obtained extensive experience while serving four combat tours in Iraq (1x) and Afghanistan (3x). He also gained additional experience while serving as an Emergency Manager and Antiterrorism Officer for the Office of the Assistant Secretary of the Army (Acquisition, Logistics, & Technology). He also served as the Senior Military Instructor for the Texas Christian University, University of North Texas, and Baylor University (ROTC programs).

Mr. Rogers is known for his keen ability to motivate others and assess and implement programs to improve individual and collective performance. As a result, officials at the Federal level rated many of his methods as Best Practices and many officials adopted his program entirely. Additionally, due to his extensive knowledge in personal protection and crisis management, his services are commonly requested by others to advise or support special events. Throughout the years, he directly planned, organized or supported notable special events, including award ceremonies, collegiate, and professional football games, foreign visits, and served on various personal protection details for high-risk personnel.

Due to the existing and forecasted threat environment posed by natural hazards and human-caused events, Mr. Rogers felt it was essential to develop a business strategy to serve not only large companies but also individuals and small businesses.

Mr. Rogers has received numerous awards and accolades throughout his career. He's a recipient of two Bronze Star Medals, received the Best Antiterrorism Program for large facilities (2022), and was recognized by officials from the Pentagon Force Protection Agency as the Best Antiterrorism Officer of the Year (2018). Additionally, he received the Larry Stickland Educational Leadership Award from TCU. He was recognized several times for demonstrating exemplary leadership and performance by former President George W. Bush, former Joint Chiefs of Staff Admiral Mike Mullen, and Joint Special Operations Commander Admiral William McRaven.
