Jennifer Brown, was selected SoMD 2030 Workforce Development Director and TPP Programs Director in November 2022. Brown originally joined The Patuxent Partnership (TPP) as the Programs and Membership Director in May 2017. Prior to joining TPP, Brown worked in higher education for 17 years- most recently, as the Assistant Director for Webster University's National Capital Region at the Southern Maryland Higher Education Center from 2014-2017. facilitator for the National Coalition Building Institute (NCBI), an international non-profit organization dedicated to leadership development, prejudice reduction and conflict resolution for 15 years. Brown also completed one year of service for AmeriCorps, serving as a Literacy Coordinator, in Western MD.
