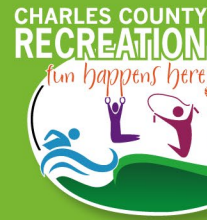

Junior Lifeguard Camp

This camp is designed to teach the responsibilities and duties of being a lifeguard – basic rescue skills, first aid, CPR, and water safety. Upon completion, campers receive certification in first aid and an American Red Cross Junior Lifeguard completion certificate. Campers must be able to swim one length of the pool (25 yards of freestyle and breaststroke), tread water for 1 minute, float for 30 seconds, and swim underwater for 10 yards.
