These changes include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All visitors must check in at front desk. • All visitors will be required to wear a wristband. • No one under age 18 (except if the parent of a patient) is permitted to visit the hospital or outpatient areas, including waiting areas and common spaces. • Only 1 adult visitor allowed per patient for all areas of the hospital and outpatient facilities. • Visitors may be screened for flu-like symptoms — runny nose, fever, cough —and are not permitted to visit the hospital if symptoms are present. • Visitors with international travel may not visit for 14 days after arrival into the U.S.
