




NEW CHART FOR POSITIVITY RATES FOR CHARLES. (last






Peak in hospitalization rate coincided with the peak in the skilled nursing facility outbreaks.</p> <p>Among confirmed cases, 1263 (56.9%) Female; 937 (43.1%) Male</p> <p>8.4% Healthcare Workers</p> <p>1% First Responders: EMS, Fire, Law Enforcement</p> <p>65% have underlying health conditions</p>
	<p>91 confirmed deaths no changes since previous report</p> <p>There have been 91 confirmed deaths associated with COVID-19. This equates to 4.2% of total confirmed cases. The Charles County death rate of 4.2% is higher than the MD state average death rate of 3.5%. However, it should be noted that the majority of deaths in Charles County are associated with outbreaks in skilled nursing facilities. The death rate for Charles County is going down from a high of 7.3% now that the outbreaks at skilled nursing facilities have been contained and/or reduced.</p> <p>There were 2 probable COVID-19 deaths. 
